

General Safety Information

Before installation, read the following instructions carefully. Failure to follow instruction and Safety information could cause serious bodily injury, death and/or property damage. Each Power-Flo pump is individually factory tested to insure proper performance. Closely following these instructions will eliminate potential operating problems, assuring years of trouble-free service.

AWARNING

 Risk of electric shock. To reduce risk of electric shock, always disconnect pump from power source before handling.



DO NOT SUBMERGE PUMP OR LOCATE PUMP WHERE WATER WILL COME IN CONTACT WITH MOTOR. NOT FOR USE IN WET LOCATIONS SUCH AS SPAS, SHOWERS OR HOT TUBS.

AWARNING

- This pump is for pumping water only, NOT intended for applications including hazardous materials such as gasoline, kerosene, etc.
- Pump MUST be installed with a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- Secure discharge line before operating.
- DO NOT use power cord to lift pump.
 Protect cable from cuts and punctures.
 Do not handle power cable with wet hands.

A CAUTION

- Release all pressure and drain all liquid from pump before servicing.
- DO NOT RUN PUMP DRY
- Pumps build up heat and pressure during operation-allow time for pumps to cool before handling or servicing.



This pump is **NOT** intended for use in swimming pools or any body of water with human contact. Pumps when used as a decorative water fountain pump **MUST** be used in circuit protected by a Ground Fault Interrupter.

 Bronze/brass fitted pumps may contain levels higher than considered safe for potable water systems. Government agencies have determined that leaded copper alloys should not be used in potable water applications.

Receiving & Operation

Receiving Inspection

Upon receiving the pump, it should be inspected for damage or shortages. If damage has occurred, file a claim immediately with the company that delivered the pump. If the manual is removed from the packaging, do not lose or misplace.

Electrical Connections

This pump is supplied with a three prong grounding plug. A shock hazard and serious injury can result if the plug is connected to an ungrounded outlet. Pump should be connected to a three prong grounded outlet with a ground fault interruptor. **DO NOT REMOVE THE GROUND PRONG!**

Operation

Locate pump no more than 15 ft above or away from inlet source.

Use only reinforced hose or rigid pipe for the suction hose. Make sure all connections are tight and free of leaks. Leaks on suction side will reduce the efficiency of the pump and may prevent priming.

A regular garden hose may be used on the discharge side.

Prime pump by removing plug and fill pump body with water. Replace plug.

Plug pump into a GFCI receptacle. The pump takes several minutes to prime. The priming time depends upon the suction line length and vertical distance between the pump and inlet source.


When pumping from a source where foreign objects or small debris may be sucked into the pump a strainer is recommended on the suction side and one that does not restrict the flow of water into the pump.




PFACE Utility Pumps



LIMITED WARRANTY

Manufacturer warrants, to the immediate purchaser and subsequent initial owner during the warranty period, every new pump to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service, when properly used and maintained, for a period of eighteen (18) months from date of manufacture or twelve (12) months from date of installation (which ever comes first). Failure due to wear due to excessive abrasives is not covered. The initial owner is the purchaser who first uses the pump after its initial installation, or for nonpermanent installation, the first owner who uses the pump. The date of installation shall be determined by a dated sales receipt noting the model and serial number of the pump. The dated sales receipt must accompany the returned pump. Product will be repaired, replaced or remanufactured at Manufacturer's option. No allowance will be made for shipping charges, damages, labor or other charges that may occur due to product failure, repair or replacement.
